

7th Grade High School Visitation Day

The archdiocese offers a High School Visitation Day to Archdiocesan High Schools for **7th Grade Students**. This is in lieu of the former 8th Grade Visitation Day. The official Visitation Day takes place on Wednesday, March 20, 2019 beginning at 8:30am. This is a wonderful opportunity for students to attend classes and evaluate the opportunities available at our high schools. Therefore, there will be no classes at St. Elizabeth for 7th graders on March 20th and students are expected to attend the Visitation Day at an area Archdiocesan High School. Since most of our students will attend the event at Bishop Shanahan High School, we have posted their schedule with this flyer. If you plan to attend a different Archdiocesan High School, please contact that school for more information.

Please note the following:

- Transportation will not be provided from Saint Elizabeth School to Bishop Shanahan High School. Parents should arrange transportation for their student.
- All students should wear their Saint Elizabeth Spring Uniform to Visitation Day, wherever they visit.
- A list of students will be sent to Bishop Shanahan, so you do not need to “sign up” to attend. However any students who do not attend the Visitation Day will be marked absent from school.
- Please notify the homeroom teacher if your student will be visiting a school other than Bishop Shanahan High School.
